8 In the past, attempts have been made to provide a multi-layer coextrusion head in which a hollow extrusion is formed by extruding plastic material through at least one hollow die. The hollow die has a central orifice through which a hollow plastic material is extruded. An outer surface of the hollow die has a second orifice through which another material is extruded. The second orifice may be coaxial with the central orifice of the hollow die. The extrusion through the first orifice is coaxial with the hollow die and the extrusion through the second orifice is coaxial with the extrusion through the central orifice of the hollow die. The extrusion through the second orifice is a solid plastic material that is melt-coated onto the extrusion through the central orifice of the hollow die. One of the problems with this process is that the melt-coated second extrusion typically cools quicker than the extrusion through the central orifice. This can lead to blockages in the extruder that can cause stoppages and other manufacturing problems. Another problem with the process is that the plastic material extruded through the central orifice and the melt-coated second orifice is extruded as a single mass of plastic material. This can lead to many problems such as co-mingling of the two different materials, the mixing of the two materials and other problems. It would be desirable to provide a multi-layer extrusion head that would obviate and/or mitigate the aforementioned disadvantages.
