A "person" is legally defined as an individual or a group, whereas a natural person (i.e. you and I) is a "non-person" and is not protected by criminal law. Even then you're only protected when you actually suffer damages. Nowadays, most nations define "person" as including corporations (usually ones worth a few thousand dollars) but there are countries that still don't. The US is one of them, while Canada and Australia are the others. Pirating is a different matter. While in most jurisdictions criminal law is not available to non-persons, "civil law" and "tort law" can be used to get damages from "persons" (i.e. corporations and individuals). The Pirate Bay is not a corporation nor a natural person. The founders are what might be called individuals. By definition, they are not protected by criminal law. However, they may have been subjected to civil law actions. The actions of individuals are not to be decided by the public, rather they are decided by "their peers". Simply put, no one who has not been convicted or even charged is considered a peer. But, in the world of law, everyone is considered a peer until proven otherwise, then they are not. And, in a certain sense, there is no crime of "infringement". The band "The Beatles" was sued by a record label for "piracy" in the US. Their defense was that since they had not paid the label (or anyone else, for that matter) for the right to record, distribute and sell their songs, they were not violating any law. The record label lost. In other words, if you have a record label, you are not supposed to pay anyone to do anything. This is because you are the record label.
