The objective of the study was to evaluate the safety, feasibility, and clinical outcomes of early mobilization in obese patients postoperatively. Included in this study were 147 consecutive obese patients aged 32-93 years, admitted for elective cardiac surgery and discharged directly home after a median of 7 days in an intensive care unit. The patients were randomized in a double-blinded fashion to a control group (n = 66) or an intervention group (n = 81) to mobilize slowly for the first 5 days after leaving the intensive care unit. Our data showed that obese patients mobilizing slowly from the intensive care unit for the first 5 days had shorter times to mobilization and discharge (determined by allocation of rehabilitation therapists [control vs. intervention groups = 75.5 [18.0] vs. 58.6 [14.6] h (P
